Winemaking: The grapes were picked early in the morning and pressed together quickly to minimise colour pick up. After settling the juice was fermented with a neutral yeast and aged on lees for five months. Bottled early Spring 2017.

Tasting note: Very pale colour with notes of strawberry, wet earth and violets. The palate is full bodied and rich with a soft texture and a long finish. Enjoy chilled.
